ORGANIZATION SUMMARY

The St. Croix Long-Term Recovery Group (LTRG) is a cooperative body that is made up of representatives from faith-based, non-profit, government, business and other organizations working within St. Croix to assist individuals and families as they recover from Hurricane Maria. The goal of the LTRG is to unite recovery resources with community needs in order to ensure that even the most vulnerable in the community recover from the disaster.

OUR MISSION

Some survivors affected by the hurricanes do not meet the eligibility criteria for government or federal aid. This is where the LTRG come into play. Our role is to provide these survivors with assistance such as debris removal, home repairs, feeding their families, financial or medical assistance. The LTRG is now assessing members in the community and providing them with the assistance they need to recover.

The mission of the St. Croix LTRG is to help the members independently provide community services on a daily basis and provide effective relief and recovery services to people affected by disaster on the island of St. Croix.

OUR WORK

The LTRG on St. Croix worked with the FEMA Disaster Survivor Assistance team to provide a wheelchair to a member of a local church; removed debris so that power could be restored to the survivor's home. The group is mobilizing volunteers to help train local residents in new skills, so they can work on recovery efforts well into the future. They will continue to bring people together to support grassroots recovery efforts and find solutions for some of the major challenges Virgin Islanders continue to face after the disaster.
